- Ms. Oregon Rose (Ages 25+)
- Mrs. Oregon Rose (Ages 18+, must be married)

- Community Service Summary

6. WARDROBE GUIDELINES

Orientation:

Casual but presentable (no crop tops or sweats)

Interview:

Age-appropriate interview dress or business attire

Fun Fashion:

Expressive and stylish outfit (no swimwear or overly revealing attire)

Evening Gown:

Formal, floor-length gown (except Tiny Miss and Little Miss may wear tea-length)

On-Stage Question:

Same as Evening Gown

7. JUDGING CRITERIA

Contestants are judged on:

- Interview (25%)
- Evening Gown (25%)
- Fun Fashion (20%)
- On-Stage Question (10%)
- Community Service (20%)

8. Awards and Titles

- Oregon Rose Division Queens
- 1st and 2nd Runners-Up
- Special Awards (Community Service, Spirit of Oregon, etc.)

9. ENTRY FEES

- Fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Please allow up to 5 weeks to receive sash as they are being custom made and may take some time to get back.

10. IF YOU WIN

Oregon Rose titleholders represent their division for one year. Winners will:

- Receive their official crown, sash, and additional prizes (based on sponsorship contributions)
- Appear at community events and local charities
- Promote their personal platform and the Oregon Rose Pageant
- Must agree to attend the following year's pageant to crown their successor.

11. PAGEANT WEEKEND INFORMATION

The Oregon Rose Pageant is currently scheduled to take place in **Salem, Oregon**. Please note that this location is **subject to change** based on availability and final event planning.

All **official venue details** will be communicated to **registered participants via email** closer to the event date.

Arrival: Check-in, orientation, Interview will occur on Day 1.

Day 2: Final Show

Departure: Contestants may depart following the final show on Day 2.

Please note that the event may extend beyond two days, depending on the number of delegates registered. If needed, age divisions will be split, with younger delegates competing on one day and older delegates on the next

Meals, transportation, and accommodations are the responsibility of the contestant. Chaperones are required for minors.

12. RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. Contestants must compete in the correct age division.
- 2. All fees are non-refundable.
- 3. Poor sportsmanship may result in disqualification.
- 4. Contestants agree to be photographed and filmed for promotional purposes.
- 5. Contestants and guardians release Oregon Rose Pageants LLC from liability.
- 6. Contestants may not hold another state/national title in a similar system during their reign.
- 7. Must be natural born female.
- 8. All decisions by judges and directors are final.

13. CODE OF CONDUCT & EXPECTATIONS

At the Oregon Rose Pageant, we strive to create a welcoming and respectful environment where all delegates, families, and team members feel valued and supported. As representatives of this system and your communities, it is essential that behavior reflects the values of confidence, character, and community at all times, both in person and online.

The following behaviors are strictly prohibited:

- Bullying of any kind, including verbal, physical, or cyberbullying
- **Harassment**, including inappropriate comments, threats, or unwanted behavior toward others
- Gossiping, spreading rumors, or creating division among delegates, families, or staff

Extreme or disruptive behavior that affects the integrity or atmosphere of the program

Inappropriate social media content (photos, videos, comments, reposts, or
 interestina) that recovered at a content (photos, videos, comments, reposts, or

interactions) that may reflect poorly on the individual or the Oregon Rose Pageant brand

We expect all participants to conduct themselves with kindness, professionalism, and courtesy—both on and off the pageant stage.

Violation Policy:

Any concern or report regarding a violation of this policy will be taken seriously. The Oregon Rose Pageant reserves the right to investigate all matters brought to our attention. Depending on the severity and outcome of the investigation, consequences may include:

A verbal or written warning

• Temporary suspension from appearances or events

Dismissal from the Oregon Rose Pageant system without a refund
